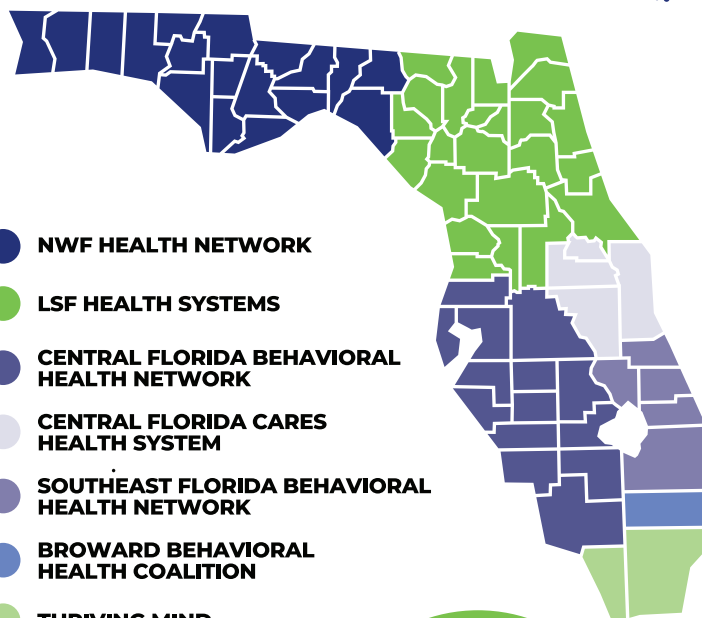


Managing Entities At-a-Glance

Return on Investment



98% of children with behavioral health needs diverted from juvenile justice system involvement and 97% from state Inpatient Psychiatric Program, saving Florida approximately \$34 million.*



Diverted 96% of crisis calls from higher level intervention, helping Florida maintain one of the lowest suicide rates among large states in the U.S.*



Care Coordination success by diverting 96% of individuals from costly crisis stabilization units, hospital emergency rooms, and jails.



Mobile Response Teams diverted 80% of individuals from a Baker Act admission, saving Florida approximately \$12.2 annually.*



Managing Entities' collective operating rate is 3.12%, which is far below the industry standard operational rate.
